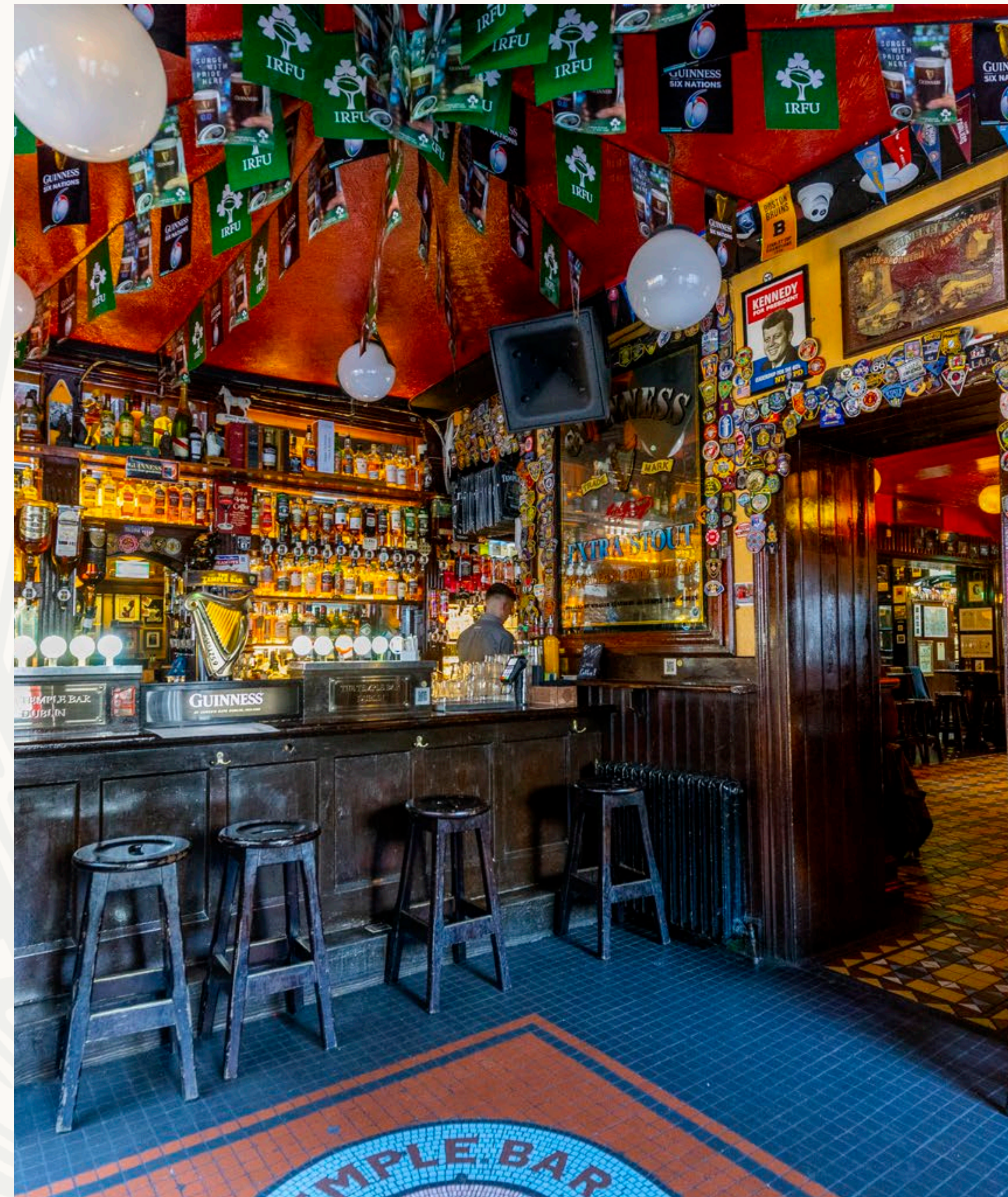

Evening:

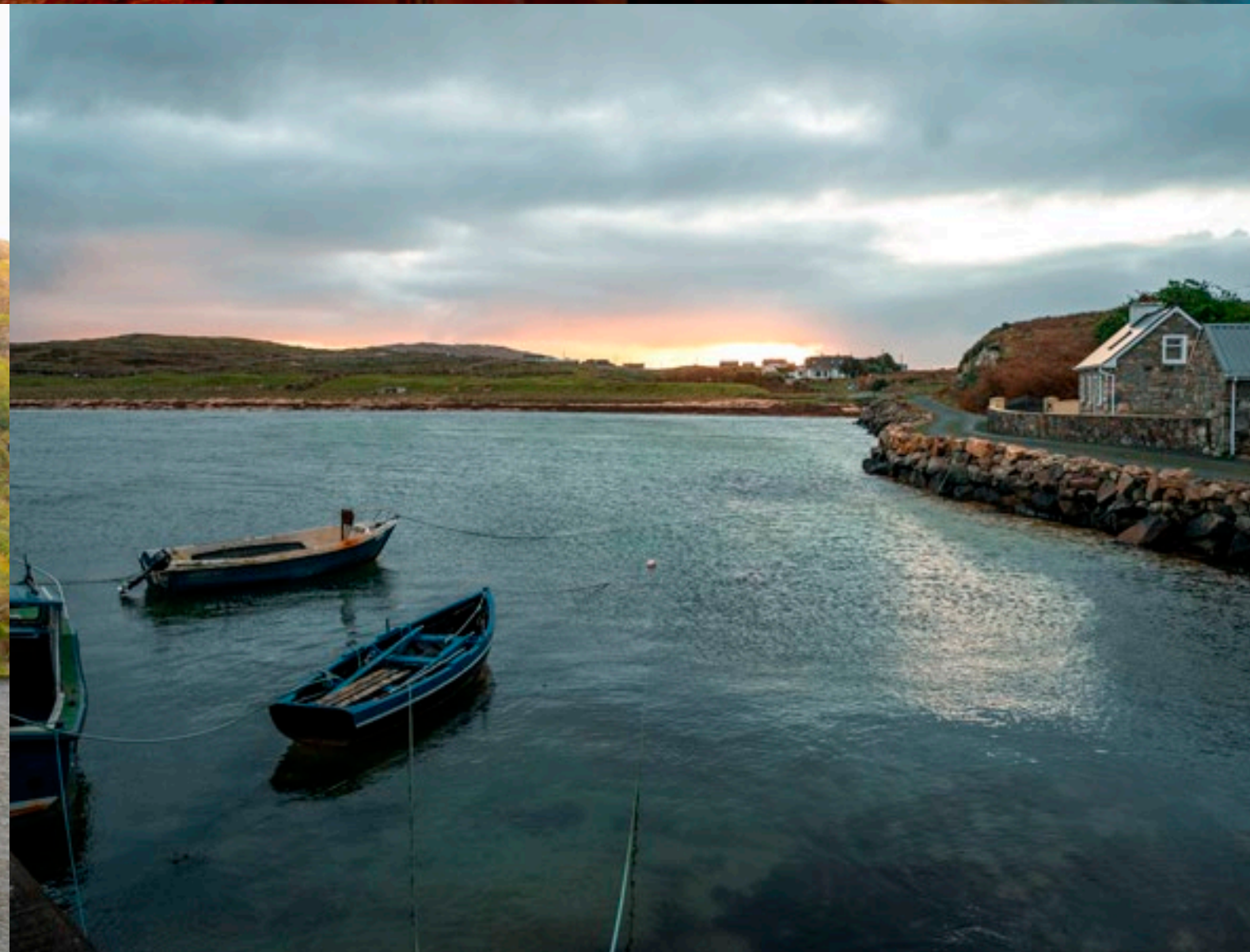
- Experience Galway's renowned pub scene, where live traditional music, craic, and warm hospitality fill the night.
